01 PROJECT RECAP

In January, Welsch Wind Power focused on completing its Alberta Environment & Parks (AEP) engagement with the submission of a Construction Monitoring Plan and Post-Construction Monitoring Plan reports, in accordance with the latest wildlife directives and in coordination with the regional AEP biologist. As part of this impact-mitigation approach, WWP took a proactive step in removing turbine locations to avoid and protect sensitive wildlife areas.

02 CURRENTLY UNDERWAY

In parallel to the work with the AEP, WWP has been working with Transmission Facility Owner (TFO) AltaLink to align the In-Service Date with the AUC Permit for which WWP submitted an amendment application. The results of this discussion will be detailed in the February newsletter to landowners.
